



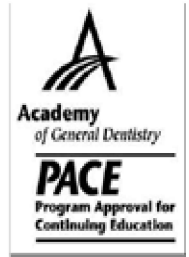

Presenter:

Dr. Martin Denbar is one of the two doctors that introduced the field of Oral Appliance Therapy for the treatment of Obstructive Sleep Apnea to Texas over 30 years ago. With over three decades of experience performing Dental Sleep Medicine, Dr. Denbar has a record of treating over 6000 patients with mild to moderate apnea and over 900 severe cases using Combination Therapy with an Interface. He is nationally recognized as one of the leaders in the field, helped write the first Diplomate examination in 1998, developed new medical devices and treatment techniques, published in regional, national and international medical and dental professional publications, and lectured on the national scene to both physicians and dentists.

On a personal note, Dr. Denbar is a native Texan and obtained his doctorate at the University of Texas School of Dentistry in Houston in 1975. During his formal educational journey, he has been inducted into numerous national honor societies. After graduating with his doctorate, he joined the United States Navy Dental Corps and served with the Third Marine Division Fleet Marine Forces at Camp Pendleton, California and in Okinawa, Japan. As the battalion dentist for the Logistic Support Unit, Second Battalion, Ninth Regiment, Third Marine Division, he was part of Operation Paul Bunyan in Korea in 1996.

His private practice for over a decade has been dedicated to Dental Sleep Medicine exclusively. He and his wife of 44 years enjoy the country atmosphere on their ranch outside of Austin. The ranch

allows fishing and hunting with their kids and grandkids, relaxing on his tractor, maintaining their butterfly garden, and putting in new gardens when time allows.
